- 7. All fees must be paid on time at the beginning of each term.
- 8. All students must be punctual and regular in their attendance.
- 9. Parents are responsible to collect their children on time or make alternative arrangements prior notice must be given during office times if unable to collect on time.
- 10. Absence by a student for 10 days or more without notification may automatically terminate his/her place at the madrassah.
